Urban Legends

The sunroof cars below are stories that I have run across on the web - but don't have any real evidence that they exist.

1971 FJ6 sunroof GTX, 440 6bbl / 4-spd.

Owner posted on the RRNest forum about a car that he used to own - until the divorce:

"It was a sassy grass one with a sunroof and black vinyl top. It had chrome bumpers, duals with tips and an air grabber. It had a 4 sp console, p/w and p/l that was pretty rare for a runner. Another option that it had was the drivers aid package that included the low fuel, door ajar and seat belt indicator along with interior light package. It had the factory tach and the super track pac rear."

1971 GB5 sunroof GTX

Spoke with a Mopar enthusiast on 4/16/2022. He remembers seeing a GB5 Blue sunroof GTX at the New Hamberg, Ontario show around 2000. He took pictures of the car and the broadcast sheet, but when developed, they were blurry and the sheet was unreadable.
